Renée helped form Personas Ayudando a Todos los Animales, A.C., in July 2005 after seeing a need for animal welfare programs to reduce the overpopulation of dogs and cats on the streets of Manzanillo.

In March 2006 she organized the first 3-day MASH-style sterilization clinic to spay/neuter pets of low income families at no cost to the owners. Since then Personas Ayudando a Todos los Animales has hosted clinics each March and has sterilized more than 1,700 animals at no cost to the owners in just four years paid for by fundraisers held on the local level.

As a founding member of Personas Ayudando a Todos los Animales, Renée ran most of the day to day operations, including fundraisers, clinics, volunteers, and publicizing the organization. In 2008, Renée coordinated a team from the Rural Area Veterinary Services (RAVS) branch of the Humane Society of the United States (HSUS) to conduct a free professional development teaching clinic for local Manzanillo vets. They returned the following year in 2009 to establish a formal teaching program with the local veterinary university in Tecoman, Colima.

Renée graduated from Queen's University in Kingston, Ontario, Canada with a Bachelor of Arts degree in English literature and sociology. She worked for several years as a newspaper reporter and freelance writer for Canada's national newspaper The Globe and Mail and other publications.
